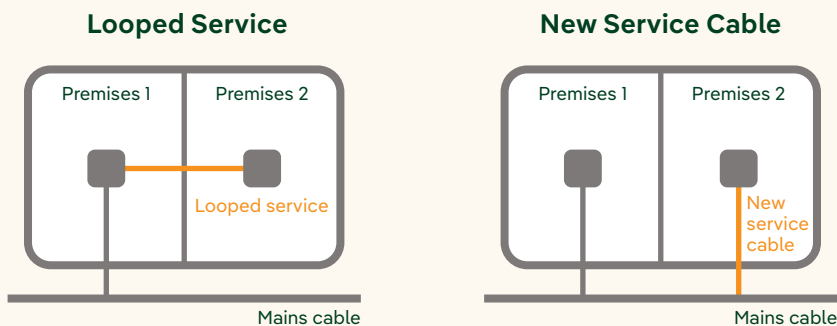
What will the works help support

Health and safety - removal of VIR and Pyro cable.

VIR (Vulcanised Indian Rubber) and old pyro cables are removed because their insulation deteriorates over time, creating serious risks of electric shock, fire, and electrical failures, and they are no longer compliant with modern safety standards.

What is a Loop Service?

Most modern properties will have a single underground service cable which provides a direct electricity connection to our network. There are however many older properties connected historically that share a single service, we call this a 'looped service'.



What to expect:

- ✓ Visit from our project organiser to explain works
- ✓ Dig and use of vac ex for safer quicker digging
- ✓ Deloop jointing works take place
- ✓ Reinstated taking place
