Welcome to the SP Electricity North West Supplier Portal, where suppliers can find out information on what they need to do to be eligible to work with us.

SP Electricity North West is one of 14 [distribution network operators](#) in the UK regulated by [Ofgem](#). Our network in the North West is one of the most reliable in the country and we are investing £1.7bn between 2023-28 to ensure we continue to deliver an excellent, safe and affordable service to all our customers.

SP Electricity North West sit within ScottishPower and ultimately the Iberdrola group. We are now part of the second largest distribution network operator in the UK, delivering electricity to around 12 million people across a network spanning more than 170,000 kilometres.

Procurement processes, systems and supplier requirements are consistent across the Iberdrola group.

Becoming a SP Electricity North West supplier is just a click away. Thanks to our Supplier Management System platform, managed by the company GoSupply, it is a simple process to join SP Electricity North West as a supplier. The entire management cost of the new Supplier Management System is assumed by SP Electricity North West, and the supplier is free from paying any annual subscriptions.

With the support of GoSupply and the information provided by the supplier, as well as third parties, **we evaluate the supplier** in areas such as: occupational risk prevention, financial aspects, cybersecurity and sustainability, among others.

If you are then invited to participate in a tender process, you will need to register in SAP Business Network, and provide additional information in GoSupply. All this is with a view to maintaining your relationship with us in an efficient and secure manner.

1. Do you want to become a SP Electricity North West supplier?

Depending on the critical nature of the supplier, Iberdrola group will require a certain level of registration and classification on the new platform:

- **Elementary Level:** Applications from **NEW** suppliers who are looking to work with us. A new supplier is one that has not worked with the ScottishPower group before.
- **Basic Level:** Active, but not critical, suppliers of non-strategic goods and/or services or those which are not technically complex and purchases for minor amounts.
- **360° Level:** Suppliers of strategic and critical products and/or services and purchases for significant sums or a large contracting volume. Purchases under framework arrangements.

If you are already a supplier to the ScottishPower Group, you do NOT need to register again on the Elementary level.

The Elementary level is the first step to become a future SP Electricity North West supplier.

2. Registration process in SAP Business Network

If SP Electricity North West wants to invite a supplier who is registered at GoSupply Elementary level to participate in a tender, we need to get to know you better through a registration process in our systems. For this, you must be invited via email to create an account in SAP Business Network
